Collection 3 New Jersey Zines [“Jer-Zines”] Collection

History

Short for “fanzine” and pronounced “zeen,” zines are do-it-yourself, self-published, and usually made on paper and reproduced with a photocopier or printer. Zine makers are often motivated to share knowledge or experience on whatever topics interest them, such as music, art, politics, poetry, comics, personal thoughts, and reviews.

Scope & Contents Note

The titles in this collection all originate from New Jersey or have New Jersey as a topic. Most of the older zines [acc. #2017.27] were collected for a Zine Fest curated by *Laugh Clown Laugh* and held in Red Bank, N.J., June 8-15, 1996 [the program is filed in the *Laugh Clown Laugh* folder]. Many of the non-Jersey zines from this show are located in the circulating zines collection at the Library, along with newer zines currently being collected. “Extras” (artwork, letters, etc.) have been filed together in the last box if they are not connected to a particular title. An attempt was made in 2021 to contact all addresses in order to notify them of the creation of the collection, and to ask for more if they had any. Those marked with an * were returned as “undeliverable.”
